Elizabeth:

- has obtained a new debit card for our bank account

- ODOT update: they will be closing intersections along Powell at:
 - 36th, 42nd, 45th, 47th
 - We wonder if this is related to jurisdictional transfer of Powell to PBOT
 - Comment period:
 - Unknown
 - Rachel moves to send a letter to ODOT
 - Include:
 - Compliance with a regulation should not result in an unsafe situation
 - Unnecessary burden on people with disabilities to use that corridor along a high crash corridor
 - Jonathan offered to make map of existing cross walks
 - John Legler seconds motion to send a letter, passes unanimously
 - It might be good to coordinate with other neighborhood associations
 - Brooklyn, Hosford-Abernethy, Richmond, Foster-Powell
 - Rachel will check with SEUL to see if they know
 - Elizabeth knows that the bike community is also mobilized
- Rachel asks for reimbursement for \$72 annual Weebly fee for CKNA website
 - Elizabeth moves to reimburse, John seconds, passes unanimously
- Rachel moves to approve the Secretary of State filing fee of \$50
 - Darian seconds, passes unanimously

Elizabeth moves to adjourn the meeting, Rachel seconds. Passes unanimously.
